

# Teaching Assistant apprenticeship.



Teaching Assistants are responsible for delivering individual and small group teaching and adapting planning under the direction of a teacher. They also work in partnership with other professionals within the school and education system, as well as with learners' parents or carers.

## What knowledge and skills will an apprentice learn?

Apprentices will learn through online workshops and one-to-one sessions with a Get Set UK Learning Development Mentor and specialist trainers, covering:

- O How to provide feedback in development, health & safety responsibilities, safeguarding, mental health and submitting referrals.
- O Effective communication techniques for different audiences, the impact of enrichment activities on learner development and the learning, assessment and feedback cycle.
- O Apply learning resources, tech, and curriculum frameworks to meet outcomes.
- O Methods of observing, recording, and reporting learner progress, and applying teaching strategies and interventions to support diverse learning needs.
- O Setting clear learning targets, tracking progress, and supporting both academic and personal development to help learners succeed.

## What experience will the employer need to provide?

The apprentice will need to have the opportunity to regularly carry out the following tasks:

- O Practice strategies that promote independent learning while using behaviour management techniques in line with policies.
- O Create an inclusive environment where learners adapt communication and build positive relationships.
- O Access and use a variety of resources and adapt them to support diverse learning needs.
- O Use assessments to guide development.
- O Observe, record and report on learner progress, using assessments to track and guide development.

## What is involved in the end-point assessment (EPA)?

- O Observation with questions
- O Professional discussion underpinned by a portfolio of evidence
